Wednesday 14th february is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the season of Lent. There will be 3 masses at 7.30am, 9.30am and 7.30pm.

Reflection – "We begin lent on Wednesday. There is always a danger that we might want to focus on ourselves and on our own efforts at conversion. However, we must focus on God. The prophet Joel reminds us 'God is all tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in graciousness and ready to relent'. God is more anxious for us to repent and to turn to him again than we are. God is more than ready to pour this grace and forgiveness into our hearts, all we have to do is ask! Prayer, fasting and almsgiving attune us to God's voice and open our hearts to his transforming power. Joel also stresses the need to 'call the people together, to summon the community' lent is the time when we think not just of our selves but of those around us, fellow members of our own Christian community. We have a duty to pray for them, to help and encourage them as much as we can".

# CAFOD Family Fast Day - Friday 23 February 2018.

"You have been a bridge from a world of suffering to a better world."

The above quote comes from Marian, a Zimbabwean Mother and now Market Gardener, following the vegetable seeds she and her community received from CAFOD. Whilst the Fast day is a symbolic act of love and solidarity for people who have to go without food, it is also an important fundraising activity for CAFOD to support their works. To this end, Fast Day Envelopes for our donations will be available at all masses of Sunday 18 February 2018, and collected across all masses of Sunday 25 February. This year our donations will be matched pound for pound by the UK Government up to the amount of £5M, and further a UK Tax Payer can Gift Aid their donation to allow CAFOD to claim back the basic 20% tax. This will see a pound donation equating to £2.20. More information of the Government pound for pound, and Gift Aiding your donations can be found in the Church lobby, as can Marian's story. #### **Department for Education**

The Department for Education is considering how to update the existing Sex and Relationship guidance which, was last updated in 2000, and is therefore now out of date. The updated guidance will support schools in delivering the new subjects of Relationships Education at primary schools and Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) at secondary schools, as well as, potentially, Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE). Under the draft proposals parents will not be permitted to withdraw their children from certain aspects of RSE.
