Jesus the healer

I had a dream that I came to the Lord trembling, ashamed, fearful and sad. And I told him my tale of betrayals.

Afterwards I went away airborne with joy.

Nathan confronts David. God has given him so much and would give it all again, still David sought the forbidden treasure of Uriah's wife. Analogous with the fruit of the tree in the garden, the heart often longs for what it cannot have; leading to all kinds of difficulty. David shows remorse and God relents from his anger.

Second Reading: Galatians 2: 16, 19-21

True life is in Christ. Paul eloquently explains that everything he says and does is rooted in the Paschal Mystery. Christ's free gift of himself, the ransom paid for sin. The fruit of the Tree of Life, the Cross, is the promise of eternal life in God.

Gospel Reading: Luke 7: 36 - 8: 3

The woman who showed Jesus her sorrow by tears and anointing is forgiven much because of her great love.
