GAINING AND LOSING

3rd September

There is a way of losing by gaining. You can win an argument but lose a friend. Through competition and promotion I may advance in my profession, but in terms of relationships I am impoverished. My energies are so focused on efficiency and success that I haven't time to grow emotionally and to develop my capacity for relationships. In one's drive to obtain power, a person may sacrifice friendship and loyalty, so much that one ends up alone. Lord, let me never forget your haunting words: "What good will it do to you to gain the whole world if you lose your soul?"

HARDEN NOT YOUR HEART

10th September

'O that today you would listen to his voice. Harden not your hearts.' From a spiritual point of view, hardness of heart is one of the worst things that can happen to anyone. To adopt a hard-hearted attitude is to maim oneself. A hard heart can't feel, can't respond, can't love. A hard heart can't experience joy. A hard heart is a closed heart.
