FACING OPPOSITION A REFLECTION OF PSALM 53:3-6, 8

The psalms are a great school of honest prayer, responding to God out of real-life situations. The psalmist does not hide his feelings behind a veil of piosity. If he is angry with God, he says so. If he has a problem with somebody, he says so. Here is an example of how to pray when people are out to get you. The proud have risen against me, ruthless men seek my life. The troublemakers are said to have no regard for God. But the psalmist responds in confidence: I have God for my help. He appeals to the name of God to save him and to the power of God to uphold his cause. Anybody who is unjustly opposed or accused is in good company, for it happened to Jesus and to the writer of Wisdom. Anybody who stands up for a moral ideal, sets off a negative reaction in others. The eve is made for light but light hurts the sore eye. Similarly, goodness is a reproach to the sick soul. The shape of the cross captures Jesus, the innocent victim, at the centre of negative energies coming in from all four guarters. It is important not to let the wrongs of others set up a negative agenda in your life. Our psalm turns from the wrongs of others to the praise of God. As another psalm puts it: I have found praise to foil the enemy, to silence the foe and the rebel.

CAFOD Family Fast Day – Friday 05 October 2018.

Providing Water for Life is the tag line for this year's campaign, it recognises the simple truth that we all need a reliable source of safe water to survive. At Harvest time we celebrate and share the abundance that God has given us but not all of God's Children are so lucky. This year CAFOD focus on the need for a reliable supply of clean safe water. It is no coincidence that these campaigns frequently cite the benefits of a guaranteed supply of potable water. In previous Family Fast Campaigns, CAFOD have identified the dire cost of an unreliable supply of safe water: Lengora, lives in a remote village in Uganda, that has benefited from a CAFOD sponsored project that now receives a reliable supply of clean, safe water, but this came too late for the newly born child that Lengora lost - one of the 10 villagers that died from the effects of drinking unsafe river water. More than 2 billion of our brothers and sisters do not have access to safe and readily available water at home, a figure in excess of 300, 000 children under 5 die due to diarrhoea each year, on average, a child dies every 21 seconds from a water related disease. Once again, we are invited by CAFOD to "eat simply" and give the money we save to help those less fortunate. Please try to support CAFOD's Fast Day this year, thank you.
